# Reminder - important dates

- Deadline for submitting any questions – 7 May 2009
- Last update of the FAQs on the TEN-T EA web site – 8 May 2009
- Deadline for submitting proposals – 15 May 2009
- External Evaluation – 1 to 19 June 2009
- Selection – June to August 2009



# Key points to remember

- Ensure that all parts of your application are fully completed (A, B1 and B2)
- Respond to the call to which your proposal best corresponds. Only submit your proposal for **one** call
- Submitting your proposal in English, or with an English translation, will greatly facilitate and speed up the evaluation process

- **Feedback on proposals which were not eligible** – *immediately following external evaluation process*
- **Feedback on successful proposals, and proposals not recommended for funding** – *After the decision by the TEN-FAC and scrutiny by the European Parliament (Framework Decision)*
